ICT Excellence Awards 2013

The **Ministry of Information and Communication Technology (MICT)** is organizing the third edition of the **ICT Excellence Awards** to reward the outstanding provisioning and/or use of ICT, from both Government and the Private Sector operating in Mauritius and Rodrigues.

Launched in 2011, the ICT Excellence Awards are part of the Ministry of ICT commitment to acknowledge the vital work and recognize the outstanding performance and exceptional contribution by innovators in the ICT community and organizations through the use of ICT tools and processes that have improved efficiency and effectiveness of business, government service delivery and impact to the wider community.

The **Award Gala Nite** will be held on the **6th December 2013**.

The Awards will honor the excellence of individuals and organizations that have pushed the boundaries of excellence in the following **categories**:

Mobile Application of the Year 2013

Website of the Year 2013

Young IT Person of the Year 2013 (under the age of 25)

Outsourcing Company of the Year 2013

ICT Innovative Solutions Provider 2013

Technopreneur Excellence Award 2013

ICT Organisation Excellence Award 2013 – Public Sector

ICT Organisation Excellence Award 2013 – Private Sector

ICT Personality of the Year 2013

Special Note:

(a) Institutions under the aegis of the Ministry of ICT are not eligible to participate.

(b) Organisations/individuals may participate in more than one category.

How to participate?

Prospective nominees should send a write-up proposal outlining why they deserve the respective Award. In your entry, please ensure you address the following:

- **Objectives:**
 - What are the practical applications of your product/service?
- **Innovation:**
 - How has the product/service been innovative?
- **Impact to Customers:**
 - How have the product/service impacted and benefited users (internal and external), organisations and the community?
 - What problems did it resolve?

Participants should submit their write-ups of **not more than 1,000 words** outlining the **above three requirements** to show evidence on how excellence has been achieved. Supporting documents may also be attached to enhance your submission.

Each nominee should in addition to the above, submit an explanatory note in not more than **500 words per award**, as to why the organisation/ individual deserves the specific award.
